

Washing Your PROBAN® Garment



Wash in cold or warm water.

Water temperature should not exceed 50°C. This will help protect the trimmings on the garment.

Tough stains. Use an in-wash stain remover such as Napisan*. Do not use Hypochlorite Bleach, commonly known as Chlorine Bleach, as this will affect the fire retardancy of the fabric.

Use a synthetic detergent.

Brands such as OMO*, Coldpower* and Spree* are suitable.

Correct washing ensures that the PROBAN® fire retardant properties will remain effective for the life of your garment. In order to promote ongoing protection, regular correct washing of your PROBAN® garment is recommended.
